

MOUNT ST. MARY'S OUT-OF-CONTROL GROWTH

- COMMUNITY IN CRISIS

- Fire expert's serious warning – local roadways do not comply with CA Fire Code and are too narrow for fire emergency vehicles
- History of fires, close calls, evacuations and cancelled homeowners fire insurance due to severe fire danger
- Large campus wedged in a residential hillside community
- Unpermitted enrollment and commercial events
- Currently OVER 2,000 vehicle trips per day to campus
- Access only through Bundy Canyon's congested narrow roadways declared by traffic engineer inadequate for current and future traffic

BUT MOUNT ST. MARY'S WANTS MORE

- 38,000 sq. ft. Wellness Pavilion and Events Center
- Triple enrollment from permitted 750 students to 2,244
- More events – summer camps, workshops, seminars, retreats, filming, sports activities and conferences with hundreds of attendees
- Thousands of additional car trips to Bundy Canyon and Sunset Blvd
- Large construction vehicles clogging and obstructing Bundy Canyon roads – To/From Bundy, Norman and Chalon, Sunset and I-405
