Bundy Canyon Association (BCA) is a grassroots organization of neighbors who have come together to ensure that our peace and quality of life remains intact in our beautiful Bundy Canyon.

We are committed to working on behalf of each and every one of our neighbors in our plight to end massive expansion projects in our canyon, traffic on Sunset, safety in our canyon and to stay connected to our city's officials with your comments and concerns.

As you are aware in our recent evacuation, there was issues with things like Mount St. Mary's (MSMU) brush clearance—they were cited several times over the last few years, and our BCA lead has stayed on top of this for you.

Another issue during this recent evacuation was the fact that MSMU students fled for their lives on foot, with no help from the campus, nor any notifications to students of the dangers that surrounded them. Some of those students have reached out to us and shared their horrific experience. (See student letter).

We also dealt with many people trying to get up North Norman Place and North Bundy, to try and help the nuns, even though streets were blocked with LAFD firetrucks, and support vehicles. This created havoc for evacuees trying to flee their homes and heading down the canyon.

BCA is looking at these issues and has already notified Councilman Bonin's office, the City of LA, and the school is well aware of our stance on adding to their student body and expanding on their campus. We question, since 450 of their students never received evacuation notice, how can additional students be added to this Chalon campus safely, especially when members of this campus try to head up to campus blocking pertinent evacuation routes.

You will also find enclosed a story from The Los Angeles Times on these issues, and our BCA letter that was sent to MSMU public relations person just days before the Getty Fire, imploring them of the dangers not only to our community, but to their student body, which resides on their Chalon campus.

We are here to help you and your families and appreciate your participation and help as well.
